

## Improving detection and treatment of atrial fibrillation in primary care

Our evaluation of atrial fibrillation interventions in primary care led to:

- Implementation of pulse checks in over 65s across all CCGs in North East London
- An AF toolkit being developed for commissioners and clinicians;
- Development of an Active Patient Link AF 'virtual patient review' tool to identify patients not yet anticoagulated. Redbridge CCG become second most improved of 209 CCGs in England after using this tool
- An increased evidence base for the effectiveness of early detection and anticoagulation of AF patients, supporting national implementation.
